

## **Flyers Skate Zone and Colonial Skating Club on-ice** **Code of Conduct**

### **Parents:**

As parents of a figure skater, it is important that you help guide your child by encouraging good sportsmanship. Demonstrate positive support for all skaters, coaches, and officials at every practice session, competition, and test session. Please be a positive role model by teaching your skater to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence. Coaching your child from the bleachers or players benches is strictly prohibited! Parents will be asked to leave the arena if this happens.

### **Skaters:**

Skaters must sign in and pay at the front desk before entering the ice and leave the ice promptly at the end of the session. Keep moving! No standing around, socializing is for after skating. If you fall, get up quickly unless seriously injured. Keep your head up and be aware. Give the right of way to skaters in their programs or lessons, the same courtesy will be granted to you. Abide by music rotation rules; remember that music shouldn't be played more than three times per session.

### **Prohibited Behavior:**

- Kicking, (intentionally) digging holes or scraping the ice with your blades
- Kicking the boards or damaging the ice or building
- Being verbally abusive to other skaters or coaches
- Deliberately challenging, scaring, or intentionally blocking another skater
- Videotaping anyone other than your own skater

Skaters or parents who do not abide by these rules will be asked to leave the arena.

The Flyers Skate Zone and The Colonial Skating Club follow the rules listed in the US Figure Skating Safe Sport Handbook. We expect all skaters that participate in events in this building to follow those rules as well, on and off the ice.
